Animals are not permitted in campus buildings, with the exception of service and assistance animals.

Policy Statement

Prescott College prohibits the presence of dogs or other animals in College buildings. This includes in offices, classrooms, meeting rooms, multifunctional rooms, and indoor common areas. In consideration of the health, safety, and welfare of the animal, Prescott College likewise prohibits dogs or other animals to be left unattended in vehicles parked on campus.

Pets (dogs and other animals) are allowed in outdoor common areas of the campus, provided they are under owner control, i.e. on a leash of reasonable length, and do not pose a hazard or threat to others. Dogs and other pets may not be left unattended at any time.

All pets must comply with city, county and state ordinances/statute re: licensing and vaccinations.
